STATEMENT RESPONSE

COUNTY UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE

MCA Francis Ngure Gakonga(Bahari): Thank you Madam Speaker.

Madam Speaker, I rise to respond to a statement raised by MCA Barisa Deko Bana, who in a plenary session held on 2nd November, 2023, sought to know from the Departmental Committee on Health Services and Environment on the matters regarding to County Universal Health Care.

Madam Speaker, I wish to reply as follows: -

That the mobilization and registration of indigents was done across the County from 23rd-27th February 2023. Despite accessibility and security challenges, our officers attempted to register indigents at Kiangwi, Basuba, Mararani and Milimani on the same dates. Unfortunately, the turnout was very low and only 279 indigents households were registered.

Additionally, there was a remarkable lack of essential documents noted among those who turned up for registration, all the 279 have been on boarded into the County Cover and are active members.

The following table illustrates the number of people who turned out for the registration against those with and without birth certificates.

Madam Speaker, challenges were poor turn out on registration days, lack of essential documents i.e. birth certificates, lack of photocopy and printing services and insecurity.

Proposed solutions are community sensitization by stakeholders, MCA, Religious office and council of imam to arrange outreaches and considered setting an office in the ward, consideration of setting up an ICT project to be done.

Community sensitization for early preparation of required documents, strengthening collaboration with security organs which are ongoing.

Madam Speaker, the department hopes that, the Honorable member can help the department next time by assisting in community mobilization and ensuring the people of Basuba acquire essential documents in time. In the next financial year, H.E the Governor intends to increase the number of slots to 25000 households and it is our sincere hope that more indigents from Basuba ward can benefit from the cover.
