NOTICE OF MOTION - ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNTY ECDE FEEDING PROGRAM WITH LOCAL FOOD SOURCING FROM WITU AND OTHER WARDS IN THE COUNTY

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to give the following Notice of Motion:-

Aware that, Article 53(1)(c) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides that every child has the right to basic nutrition, shelter and health care

Further Aware that, Article 43(1)(c) guarantees every person the right to be free from hunger and to have adequate food of acceptable quality

Recognizing that, under the Fourth Schedule, Part 2(9), assigns the functions of pre-primary education, including ECDE TO THE County Government.

Acknowledging that, Section 5(2)(a) of the basic Education Act, 2013 mandates the County government to provide facilities and programs for pre-primary education including School Feeding Program ensure the provision of pre-primary education including appropriate facilities and nutritional support.

Cognizant that, the National School Meals and Nutrition Strategy (2017-2022) and the National School Health Policy underscore school meals as a critical pillar for promoting enrolment, attendance, retention, and performance in early learning institutions

Concerned that, many ECDE learners in Lamu County continue to suffer from hunger and malnutrition, resulting in poor attendance, low concentration, and reduced academic performance

Noting That, Witu local dairy in Witu Ward in Lamu County has a high potential for milk production that can supply to all ECDE Cenrtes in the County, sustainably and stimulate local economic growth

Further Noting That, local sourcing of milk from Witu local dairy will create market for local farmers, reduce logistical costs and ensure freshness and traceability of supplies

NOW THEREFORE, this House Resolves that,

1. The County Government of Lamu through the Department of Education in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture formulates and implements a county ECDE Feeding program targeting all learners in public ECDE Centres
2. The Department of Education develops and submits to this House a policy and implementation frame work for the ECDE feeding program. Aligned with national education and nutrition strategies

3. The County Government prioritize the sourcing of fresh milk and other food stuff from witu ward thereby supporting local dairy and agricultural producers
4. Adequate funding for program be included in the subsequent County Annual Development Plan(CADP) and County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) for implementation
