**10.\*\*\* MOTION - APPROVAL OF LAND, PHYSICAL PLANNING AND HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT ON THE PETITION FROM RESIDENTS OF MAJENGO AREA IN MOKOWE-HINDI WARD TABLED ON TUESDAY, 27<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2025.**

**Mr. Speaker Sir,** I beg to move the following Motion:-

**THAT AWARE** that Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya guarantees every person the right to a clean and health environment.

**FURTHER AWARE** that the Environmental Management and Coordination Act (EMCA), 1999, require public consultation and environmental impact assessment (EIA) for any proposed waste management site.

**CONCERNED THAT** the construction of the waste holding site at Majengo in Mokowe town was carried out without meaningful public participation, and poses a direct threat to human health, the environment and contravenes land use policies.

**NOTING that,** the petition submitted by the people of Majengo in Mokowe and the findings of the Committee on Lands, Physical Planning and Housing confirming:-

1. Lack of public participation
2. Proximity of the site to residential and other amenities
3. Absence of a credible environmental impact assessment
4. Potential legal, social and environmental risks associated with the current location
5. Irregularity in the Construction procedures

***NOW THEREFORE, THIS ASSEMBLY RESOLVES TO:-***

1. Immediate Demolition of the constructed Waste Holding Site.
2. Instruct the Municipality to identify and relocate the project to a proper zoned area with full compliance to environmental and legal standards
3. That a comprehensive audit of the project be undertaken by County Public Accounts Committee for any legal or financial irregularities.
4. That public participation be conducted a fresh in accordance with the constitution and relevant statutes.
5. That the Lamu Municipality report progress to this Assembly within thirty days (30)
