**NOTICE OF MOTION - TIMELY INJECTION OF ANTI-RABIES DRUGS IN LAMU COUNTY**

**Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to give the following notice of motion:-**

**AWARE THAT** rabies is a deadly but preventable viral disease that is commonly transmitted to humans through bites from infected animals, especially dogs;

**FURTHER AWARE THAT** Lamu County has recorded increasing incidents of dog bites, posing a serious public health risk, particularly in rural and marginalized areas where access to prompt medical intervention is limited;

**CONCERNED THAT** delays in the administration of anti-rabies vaccines following exposure can lead to fatal consequences, and that the County Health Department has previously experienced shortages or delays in the distribution of the life-saving vaccines;

**COGNIZANT THAT** the World Health Organization (WHO) recommends immediate administration of post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) to prevent the onset of rabies in individuals who have been bitten or scratched by a suspected rabid animal;

**NOTING THAT** Article 43(1)(a) of the Constitution of Kenya provides for the right of every person to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes access to timely and adequate medical care;

**THIS COUNTY ASSEMBLY RESOLVES THAT:**

1. The County Executive Committee Member for Health ensures the continuous availability and timely administration of anti-rabies vaccines in all health facilities across Lamu County;
2. A clear and responsive emergency protocol is established to ensure immediate treatment of animal bite victims, especially in remote areas;
3. The County Government intensifies public awareness campaigns on rabies prevention and responsible pet ownership;
