The construction of the Basket Ball pitch at Twaif Ground was successfully procured and awarded to Elovass Company Limited. The Contractor was handed over at the mid of last year and started ferrying materials to the site thereafter.

**Mr. Speaker Sir,**

To date we have not received any official communication on the construction and progress of works so far from the contractor. My department technical monitoring team visited the site three months ago and also last week and found no works done so far. My office is in the process of issuing a notice of show course why the contract should not be terminated.
