Mr Speaker Sir, Pursuant to Standing Order 41(2)(C), I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Departmental Committee on Transport and Public Works on matters regarding to the Mpeketoni- Mkunumbi Road.

Mr Speaker Sir, I seek a statement from the Chairperson of the Departmental Committee on Transport and Public Works on the following:-

2. Why has the said road taken too much time to be completed?
3. How will the County Government help the residents of Mapenya and Ndambwe villages in this situation?
