NOTICE OF MOTION

SEA SECURITY- (MCA:MOHAMED ABOUD ABUBAKAR)

AWARE THAT, the people of Lamu East usually travel along the sea and Ocean waters when coming to Lamu town or other places. Majority use speed boats and dhows some big some small.

FURTHER AWRE THAT, the boats are usually used for ferrying people, timber and other luggage. Some of the residents' use them for fishing in the deep sea which is usually risky since its usually very deep and sometimes boats and dhows capsize and rescue do not happen on time

COGNIZANT THAT, every citizen has the right to safe and secure travel when using any travel means. The people of Lamu East have been deprived their rights to safe and secure travel along the sea.

CONCERNED THAT, this Assembly has passed a rescue management bill to enable the County to form a County rescue team to curb water accidents along the sea. But when an emergency occurs, the rescue team avail themselves when it is too late or sometime do not show up at all.

NOTING WITH CONCERN THAT, the most dangerous areas are; Mpupu and **Mlango Wa Chanu** that affected travelers when crossing **Manda Bay** and **Kiunga** where most boats have capsized leading to loss of lives.

FURTHER CONCERNED THAT, there are no rescue points designated in areas like; Mokowe, Kiunga, Ndau, Mtangawanda, Faza, Matondoni, Kipungani and Lamu.

THEREFORE I URGE this Assembly to compel the County Government to designate rescue points, constant sea patrols and satellite at Mlango wa Chanu and Mpupu areas to signal any vessel coming in or out in the area.
