Mr. Speaker Sir,

I beg to give the following Notice of Motion;

**Aware that** Awer and Sanye Communities are among the most marginalized in Lamu County. They are marginalized as defined by Article 260 of the Constitution. This means that their rights should be put in special consideration by this County Government.

**Further Aware** that Article 56(1) provides that the state shall put in place a fair affirmative action programmes designed to ensure that Minorities and Marginalized groups are;

**Cognizant** that Lamu County Government has developed a kitty for emergency in the County. The Awer and Sanye should be provided a special sub-kitty for their needs like, food and water.

**Concerned** that Awer and Sanye who are still hunters and gatherers are always affected by climatic changes resulting to frequent starvation and lack of important resources such as water contrary to Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

**I URGE THE HOUSE** to resolve that;

1. A sub -kitty for Awer and Sanye be established soonest possible.
2. The allocation for Awer and Sanye be used by Awer and Sanye
3. The allocation for Awer and Sanye should be specified and publicised.
4. A bill for minority and marginalized groups be established and be brought to Assembly for approval.
